**CROSS COUNTRY COURSE** – The Gidge course is situated in gently rolling parkland and has been designed and constructed by Tom Compagnoni. The course is in its seventeenth year of competition; it has been subject to continual upgrades and is riding well. The course is an excellent spectator course with most efforts visible from a point overlooking the newly improved water complex. The Showgrounds, Clubhouse, Canteen and Stable Complex adjoin the cross country course and are easily accessible.

**Emergency Contact AT EVENT:**

- When entering on KTRIALS please enter the **Emergency Contact Person** and their MOB, who must be on the grounds whilst the rider is on the grounds.

- All competitors & parents participating in Pony Club Classes must abide by the Pony Club WA Codes of Conduct.
- Medical arm bands and PC cards **must** to be sighted at registration. Rider bib/numbers are required.
- There are **NO Pony Club WA OPEN classes** in this event. Pony Club WA Annual Insurance Members **cannot** enter this event.

**HELPERS:**

- All competitors must nominate a helper over 16 years of age. Riders must include helper's mobile number.
- A standard helper duty time is 4 hours per horse.
- Self-help is limited and will be **ONLY** be by prior arrangement with the Event Secretary.
- Self-help is not available to riders of more than one horse unless completed prior to the event.
- Paid help is not self-help.
- If your allocated helper does not turn up to your duty, on time you will face immediate elimination.
- The organising committee must be notified of a change of helper, experience is required to do certain jobs.

**PAID HELPER DUTIES**

- Riders intending to use paid help must do so through the WA Helper Duty Database. Please contact Kirsten Twining - wahdd@yahoo.com Use the code **DB** in front of the helper's name and nominate **XCJJ** as the helper duty.

**WITHDRAWALS:**

- The Secretary must be notified of withdrawals by 4pm of the day prior to the commencement of the event.
- Withdrawals prior to the Event closing on KTrials will receive a full refund less a 10% admin fee.  
Refund of entries after closing date, will consist of **EA Levy**  
A portion of fees MAY be refunded at the Committee's discretion if: Helper duty is completed and/or Circumstances are considered by the Organising Committee as fair and reasonable. Refunds must be claimed within 1 week of the event.

#### DRESSAGE TESTS:

- 60m x 20m for all dressage tests. Tests found at <http://www.wa.equestrian.org.au/eventing/eventing-dressage-tests>
- **All competitors must register and pick up bib numbers before** competing in their dressage test.
- Competitors are asked to make sure that their number can be clearly seen by the judges

#### SHOW JUMPING:

- Some show jumping will be conducted on Saturday. Some classes will be required to show jump before the cross country.

#### PRIZES/PRIZE MONEY:

- As recommended by EA. Rugs and prizes subject to sponsors.

#### STABLES:

- There are 48 indoor stables available plus cattle yards on the southern side of the grounds near the dam. Please note that the stables must be left clean and tidy after use.
- Stables or yards can be booked for the entire weekend at a cost of \$50 (cash only) which includes a \$20 bond to be returned at the end of the weekend.

- **Please do not use the stable booking button on KTrials**
- Stable hire for **GH&PC members** is free but booking is essential.

#### HELMETS /HELMET CAMERA USE:

- Use of a fitted camera is at the discretion of the event Technical Delegates and **MUST** have approval prior to the start of the cross country phase starting on Sunday morning.
- The TD's availability to inspect helmet cameras will be announced on Saturday of the event.
- **NOTE: Only video nominees sanctioned by the Technical Delegate will be used for video review!**
- Helmet camera or Go Pro are **not** permitted for use by PCWA riders.
