CROSS COUNTRY COURSE – The Gidge course is situated in gently rolling parkland and has been designed and constructed by Tom Compagnoni. The course is in its fifteenth year of competition; it has been subject to continual upgrades and is riding well. The main arena has a new surface and drainage system which is a massive improvement and combined with a newly constructed X-C arena and a change of course for some grades. The course is an excellent spectator course with most efforts visible from a point overlooking the water complex. The Showgrounds, Clubhouse, Canteen and Stable Complex adjoin the cross country course and are easily accessible.

This is ONE event split over two weekends; therefore horses can only be entered in one class.

EWA classes

- Riders **must** check that their EWA membership is correct for the level that they are competing at

PCAWA classes

- PCAWA Gear checking will apply for all Pony Club Classes http://www.pcawa.com/gear_checking
- All competitors & parents participating in Pony Club Classes must abide by the PCAWA Codes of Conduct.
- Medical arm bands and PC cards **must** be sighted at registration. Rider bib/numbers are required.
- There are **NO PCAWA OPEN classes** in this event. PCAWA Annual Insurance Members **cannot** enter this event.

HELPERS:

- All competitors must nominate a helper over 16 years of age. Riders must include helper's mobile number.
- A standard helper duty time is 4 hours per horse. Limited self- help is available.
- Self help is not available to riders of more than one horse.
- If your allocated helper does not turn up to your duty, on time you will face immediate elimination.

WITHDRAWALS:

- The Secretary must be notified of withdrawals by 4pm of the day prior to the commencement of the event. Withdrawals prior to the Event closing on KTrials will receive a full refund less a 10% admin fee. Refund of entries after close will be in accordance with EA National Eventing Rules effective January 2017, however, a proportion of fees may be refunded if: (a) sufficient notice of withdrawal is given with a vet or doctors certificate and (b) a helper is provided. *Please note you are obliged to notify the Organising Committee (OC) of your intent to withdraw. It is requested that you do so as soon as possible. Refunds must be claimed within 1 month of the event.*

RESERVATION OF RIGHT:

- The Organisers or this event: Reserve the right: + to cancel any class or event + to divide any class + to transfer competitors between sections of a class + to alter the advertised times and to refuse any entry with or without stating a reason.

DRESSAGE TESTS:

- 60m x 20m for all dressage tests. Tests found at <http://www.wa.equestrian.org.au/eventing/eventing-dressage-tests>
- **All competitors must** register and pick up **bib numbers** before competing in their dressage test.

SHOW JUMPING:

- Some show jumping will be conducted on Saturday,. Some classes will be required to show jump before the cross country.

PRIZES/PRIZE MONEY:

- As recommended by EA. Rugs and prizes subject to sponsors.

STABLES:

- There are 55 indoor stables available plus cattle yards on the southern side of the grounds near the dam. Please note that the stables are left clean and tidy and in the condition prior to use.
- Stables or yards can be booked for the entire weekend at a cost of \$50 (cash only) which includes a \$30 bond to be returned at the end of the weekend.
- To avoid disappointment bookings are essential. For bookings please contact **stablesghpc@gmail.com**
- Stable hire for **GH&PC members** is free but booking is essential.

HELMETS /HELMET CAMERA USE:

- Use of a fitted camera is at the discretion of the Technical delegates and **MUST** be approved by **4pm on Saturday**
- Helmet camera or Go Pro are **not** permitted for use by PCAWA riders.
